

PURDY HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME ELIGIBILITY AND NOMINATION

The Purdy High School Athletic Hall of Fame has been established to maintain the rich heritage and tradition of successful athletic programs at Purdy High School. In addition, it will serve as a means of recognizing and honoring the athletes, coaches and individuals who made significant contributions to the athletic programs at Purdy High School and set high standards for others to emulate.

ELIGIBLE NOMINEES:

- Athlete/Team
- Coach
- Contributor (An individual who has made outstanding contributions to the interscholastic athletic programs at Purdy High School, other than in the field of coaching or student participation.)

ELIGIBLE NOMINATORS:

- Current or Former Purdy R-II School District Administration, Faculty or Staff
- Purdy High School Athletic Hall of Fame Selection Committee Members
- Purdy High School Alumni
- Purdy Community Members

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Athletes are eligible beginning ten (10) years after their Purdy High School graduation.
- Coaches must have 15 years' coaching experience and be at least five (5) years removed from the Purdy coaching staff.
- Nominees must exemplify the highest standards of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and character.
- All nominations must be submitted via the official Purdy High School Hall of Fame nomination form, found on the district website (www.purdyk12.com) or in the superintendent's or athletic director's office.
- The nomination form must be completed in its entirety. Incomplete forms will not be considered.
- The nomination form must be submitted to the Athletic Director by September 1 for consideration for induction in the current school year.
- A letter of recommendation from the Nominator must accompany nominations.
- Nominees shall remain eligible for induction for five (5) years following the initial nomination. After five years a person may be re-nominated.
